Bio

Tan Teck Heng, Alvin has been working with clay for more than two decades and has exhibited in more than 20 group shows worldwide. Teck Heng undertook traditional training in pottery and his ceramics teacher was a second- generation dragon kiln owner. In 2013, Teck Heng debuted solo shows in hometown Singapore and in Manila, Philippines. His first solo exhibition and corresponding book launch, Clay Voyage at One East Asia (Singapore), showcased two decades worth of explorations and development in his artistic practice. In 2014 he collaborated with One East Asia to co-curate and exhibit in Ceramicship, an exhibition of five Southeast Asian ceramic artists. Teck Heng has been invited to conduct demonstrations, lectures and workshops at international ceramic festivals and tertiary institutions worldwide, including Clay Push: Gulgong 2013 (Australia), Khon Kaen University (Thailand), Qi Lu Technology University (Shandong, China), and the University of Philippines. He is the recipient of a number of prestigious awards and his work is held in museums and numerous private collections. Teck Heng is the co-founder and current Vice President of the Nanyang Clay Group (NCG), the first registered pottery club in Singapore.
