

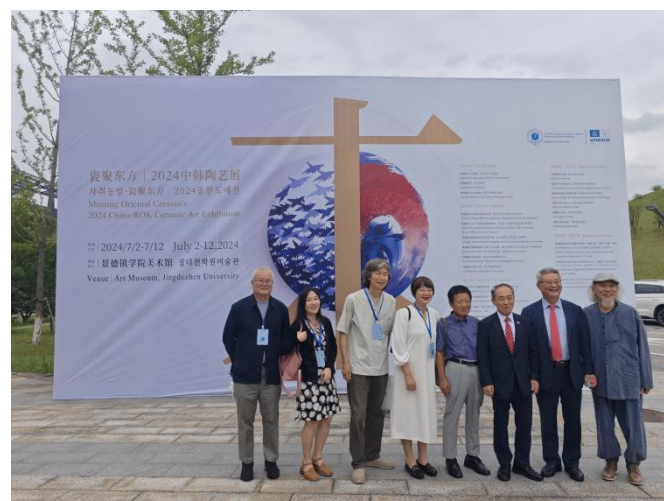
Domestic and international craft exhibitions and performances :
