

海马壶 白砂锅料

 作者出生在大连、长在海边、对大海有着特殊的 感情,海洋里的生物和精灵就是他的创作素材。
 作品展现了海马在海洋中挺立向前行进,高傲雄 姿,形态婀娜,并用少量的海水渲染。海水里增加了石英(玻璃),使得海水透彻而深奥。壶嘴为海马嘴,把手为海马尾,壶盖为海马脊背。

- 28×28 (厘米) 此作品灵感来源于海洋生物鱼类。上鱼为鳐鱼。 由于其嘴在底部、植捉樹物时它会良附在其他海 详生物身上。 蛋蓝在其背上。 角尾为肥等。 底下 为海豚鱼、 爱哉时会得今至鼓胀、 刺近起。 嘴凸 起的为壶嘴。 上鱼挂触为韭, 触色与海水色彩融 为一体; 下鱼少挂舱和不挂舱,加之泥料颗粒反 铁、表现其埋在沙海里的情景。

- 作品为沙明秋和梁文伦共同创作。绘画是陶艺的相 基,源于对色彩有感,强调色彩的感染力。经多次 反复烧制形成大立体开片,广口小足,饱满厚重。



- 作品以海洋生物螺为题材: 大鹦鹉螺与小螺的对 话。大螺壳上的年轮记录着沧桑间历及海洋的波 故, 泥条盘筑, 广口以泥板或型。由于体大把手 栽抓, 使用时需原地倾斜把水钢出; 小螺凸为盖, 便于取下注入。

English Translation of the Comments

Liang Wenlun, male, was born in 1955 into a family of paintings in Dalian, Liaoning Province. In 1979, he studied at the Central Academy of Art and Design (now Tsinghua University Academy of Fine Arts), majoring in ceramics, as a senior art artist, and serving as the president of Dalian Academy of Ceramic Arts.

The artist pursues to combine painting and sculpture art with ceramic art creation to form his own modeling language. He established his personal pottery studio in 1990, held a personal pottery exhibition for the first time in 1995, and was reported by Taiwan's *Artist* magazine. He established Wenlun pottery art workshop in 1998, CCTV International Channel gave a special report. In 2001, he participated in American Ceramic Art Education Annual Conference held in Charlotte.

Most of his works are collected by museums, included in book series, and awarded in exhibitions. In 1998, the work entitled 'Tangle• Marine Plant Series' was included in the national key book *Comprehensive Works of Modern Chinese Art*. In 1999, the work entitled 'Tangle• Marine Plant Series' was included in the Chinese Ceramic Art Gallery and participated in the Beijing China Art Fair in 2000. The work entitled 'Still Life' was included in China Ceramic Art Net. The works entitled 'Bull Soul' and 'Still Life' were included in *China Today's Ceramic Art*, and the works entitled 'Still Life' and 'Old Mansion Gate' were

included in *Modern and Contemporary Ceramic Art Appreciation and Collection*. And other magazines such as *Cotter's Newsletter, Arts Grand View, Decoration* have published his works.

In 1995, twenty-eight works of Marine Life Series were bought out by Dalian Shengya Ocean World. In 1999, 56 works were bought out by Times Group Liaoning Shopping Center. In 2000, the work entitled 'Still Life' was collected by the Ceramic Art Museum of the Faculty of Fine Arts, Tsinghua University. His works entitled 'Ting' and 'Old House' are in the permanent collection of Dalian Modern Museum.

In 2001, the work entitled 'Still Life • Collection' won the Award of Excellence in the first China Ceramic Art Exhibition held by the Chinese Artists Association. In 2003, the work entitled 'Still Life • Years' was awarded Bronze Prize in the Second China Ceramic Art Exhibition held by the China Artists Association, the work entitled 'Clone Sheep-Dolly' won the Award of Excellence. In 2005, the work entitled 'Tangle • Marine Plant Series' and 'Bull Soul' were published in the art and design education textbook *Modern Ceramic Arts* in Chinese colleges and universities.
