bio

Ursula Vogel, born in 1985, completed a traditional pottery apprenticeship in 2005. Studying ceramic design at the Applied Art School of Vevey (CEPV, 2005 – 2008), she began to further explore the materiality of ceramics and the boundaries between object, design and art.

As a founding member of Décalquai (Montreux, 2007) and goodlife productions (Zürich, 2012) - a temporary platform in art and design, which hosted an exhibition space, a residency program with a ceramic studio, and a shop. U. Vogel started a significant phase of collective productivity in spaces that fostered a public discussion on the potentialities of ceramics in art and design previously lacking. This is part of the ceramists' perspective on repositioning ceramics in the contemporary culture of art and design, aimed at establishing further common projects and long-lasting collaborations.

Since 2014, Vogel has been developing, producing and maintaining ceramics for various clients such as Restaurant Lucide, KKL Luzern, Raum 49, Zürich, Rue Hippolyte, Zürich, VARY, Winterthur and Restaurant Maison Manesse (since 2013) in her studio in Zürich.

She continues close collaborations with and produces for other artists and designers such as Küng Caputo, Izidora L. Lethe, Stefan Burger etc.

Furthermore, she is involved in cultural organisations such as the rhizome festival and OOR saloon. She participated on "failure is not an option?", Swissdesign Awards 2020, is winner of the swiss design award 2022 and was member of the Jury for the swissceramics exhibition "melting pot".

Her work is currently exposed at the Museum für Gestaltung Zürich in the exhibition "Repair Revolution!".
