Creation is like a pearl necklace: an idea is followed by another idea, a vision comes sooner or later into existence, I see an endless long way in my mind. It's a lifestyle, a 'Stil'. Standing lonely at the workshop, listening to music and having the deepest thoughts in myself.

In this context ' Japan ' refers not to the country, nor the impact of japanese ceramics, textile art or the literature, but to the effort to a sophisticated standard. Using this, a japanese craftsman or artist shapes a form, an idea not only during a lifetime, but through generations. I was moved by this striving for perfection, this gesture for reaching for the unreachable this is the starry sky, which is above me.
