Gunhild Aaberg is a Danish artist & ceramist there has been honored with The Danish Arts Foundation's lifelong Honorary Grant. She graduated in 1964 from Copenhagen School of Arts and Crafts. The same year Gunhild Aaberg - together with Jane Reumert and Beate Andersen - established their own gallery and studio – Strandstræde Keramik. In the 70'es she worked as freelance designer for the Royal Porcelain Factory and as a designer for Dansk Designs Ltd. She has been affiliated censor at the Copenhagen School of Decorative Art and Kolding School of Design as well as guest teacher at the Danish Design School and at the Jutland Art Academy. Gunhild is member of the exhibition group "Keramiske Veje" (Ceramic Ways).
