#### **Dr Andre Hess**

Andre Hess makes abstracted and elusive shapes that require the viewer to question what the pieces mean rather than what they resemble or represent, and this meaning frequently resides in the social or in viewer subjectivity. To the viewer the work is simultaneously familiar and fugitive, but always evocative of something glimpsed, as well as the history and theory of claywork. He sometimes takes shapes, colours, etc. from events in the news, such as in his body of work entitled 'Home'. The handling of the raw material significantly informs the meaning of the work. He uses any technique that fulfils the requirement. Surface treatment only qualifies what is there at the raw stage, and is achieved using slips, oxides, glazes, and frits.
