Maria Soledad Christie Ceramic Artist San Pedro de Atacama Chile

I was born in 1962 in Viña del Mar, Chile.

I have lived in San Pedro de Atacama for almost 30 years. Surrounded by a vast and amazing landscape I connect with the strength of an ancient local language; pre-Columbian pottery. Specially monochrome, black and red burnished ritual vessels.

My work is deeply rooted in the ancestral local pre-columbian pottery tradition and its ancient shaping, burnishing and firing processes. It is in the slowness of the process of building each piece where I found a sort of rhythm between volume and form, stillness and movement, balance and tension.

I make one-of-a-kind handbuilt sculptural vessels using the traditional techniques of pinching, coiling and paddling. Each piece is burnished with a small river stone several times during the drying process, in order to achieve a particular tactile surface.

I make two firings, depending on the color I am looking for, a previous low temperature gas kiln firing and then a traditional open sky firing, using lama and goat dung as fuel.

Through an on-going relation with clay, my work is meant to express intuitions and sensations that are constantly present when inhabiting this vast Atacama Desert and Altiplano territory and its outstanding atmosphere. The territory has become part of my own identity; silence, solitude and vastness have shaped me and my work immensely.
