Antonio Fois is a London based visual artist whose practice explores the relational dynamics between material, the individual, and the territory, with a particular focus on ceramics. His work often incorporates other media and research-based methods to investigate themes linked to identity, memory, and the socio-political landscape.

Born in Sardinia (Italy), Antonio holds a degree in Human Geography from the University of Sassari and completed a Master's in Ceramics and Glass at the Royal College of Art in London. This multidisciplinary background informs his approach to ceramics as both a material and conceptual language capable of addressing cultural and geographical transformation.

His work has been exhibited in a range of international contexts, and in 2024 he presented his research at the International Academy of Ceramics' biannual congress in Portugal. Through installations, sculpture, and site-specific interventions, he creates critical dialogues around place, body, and material heritage.

Antonio continues to develop projects that merge artistic practice with social inquiry, with a strong interest in fostering international exchange and interdisciplinary collaboration.
