She graduated from the Tbilisi State Academy of Art in 1982.

Lali Kutateladze is co-founder of the Georgian Ceramic Art and Craft Foundation "The Clay Office" based in Tbilisi, Georgia.

She was an associate professor at the Tbilisi State Academy of Art in 2006 – 2013.

For her, as a ceramic artist it's very important to care for popularization of the field. Exactly this was the reason for her work as a curator. Lali Kutateladze is a creator, curator and participant of many projects in ceramic, including:
