### Vivian Rosa Koelichen

## **Biography**

I was born in the south of Chile in 1957. At the age of 20 I moved to Santiago de Chile, where I studied translation and raised a family. I first became interested in ceramics in 2002, when I started attending classes at Lise Moller's Ceramic Studio in Santiago. To complement the ceramic classes, I took drawing, engraving and sculpting classes with different artists. In 2004 I quit my job as a translator and built a studio – with an electric kiln -, to devote myself entirely to ceramics, though experimenting, reading and teaching.

In 2008 I became a member at the Huara Huara Ceramic Studio to learn from and interact with all the participants in the exciting and inspiring atmosphere of this prestigious studio directed by Ruth Krauskopf. I am constantly taking part in workshops and courses conducted by Chilean and foreign ceramists.

My sculptural work is abstract. This abstraction happened gradually through doing and observing. When modelling, I am interested in capturing the essence of the ceramic object, removing any accessory. From this exercise arise pieces increasingly removed from reality. They become "another reality".

Making these sculptures entails dealing with a lot of tension and risk because I play with the precarious balance. After all that stress, all that nervousness, I seek for the result to express serenity. Chaos turns into calm, ready for reflection.

I prepare my own clay bodies to express my primary intention from de material. Some pieces incorporate metal parts. Sometimes these are fine stakes and needles that pierce through and wound; other times they cover up and repair missing parts; they protect a wound. The smoothness and sheen of the metal counterbalances the rough and matte textures of the ceramic pieces.

For my utilitarian pieces, I am inspired by traditional pottery and shapes, especially pure clean lines found in Pre-Columbian pottery. In Chile we have the privilege of having many pre-Columbian works, whose aesthetics permeates my work constantly. I like experimenting with bowls whose base is so small, they appear to float. I play with the shifting directions of the curves, or the thickness of the rim of a dish, creating sinuous lines and asymmetrical bodies; I take risks with extremely thin walls to accentuate the fragility and lightness of a piece.
