My work is organized between structure, deconstruction, and reconstruction to challenge the balance of matter and thus grasp the essential.

To move, to question using irony and seduction, are the means to achieve this.
I love shapes, colors, architecture, traces, vitality.

Breaking down techniques in favor of meaning and concept. I use different mediums: ceramics, drawing, painting, engraving, jewelry, ...

It all probably starts at the bottom of my garden when, as a little girl, I played with macocye (Liège slang for mud), but of course, I won't dwell on that.
