Nanxi Jin is an interdisciplinary artist and educator who specializes in ceramics media. Originally from Jingdezhen, China, she is currently based in Chicago. Nanxi obtained a BFA in Art & Design from the New York State College of Ceramics at Alfred University in 2020 and her MFA in ceramics from the School of Art Institute of Chicago in 2022.

Nanxi's work has been exhibited internationally, including at NYCxDesign during NYC Design Week, SOIL in Seattle, Women's Made Gallery in Chicago, and Paris Design Week in France. She received awards including the Vermont Studio Center Fellowship, and the Anderson Ranch Arts Center Fellowship. Her work "Various Vases" has been collected in Guangdong Shiwan Ceramic Museum, China. Nanxi recently had a solo show, "*Procedure*" at Longquan Wanou TaoXichuan Cultural and Creative Block Yi Gallery, Longquan China.
