# XANA MONTEIRO

Was born in Lisbon, Portugal, in 1965

Ceramist, performer and builder of wood ovens

She is a co-founder of "Desalinhados - Cerâmica em Performance" ("Misaligned Performance Ceramics"), a group of 10 potters who together, with a musician, have been performing on stage, since 2016, in cultural events.

## BACKGROUND:

In 1989 she began his training with Portuguese, Spanish, Italian, Croatian and Japanese Masters. She had a diverse learning experience: painting tiles, raku, porcelain, stoneware, building wood ovens, wheel pottery, sculpture, sigillatas lands, crystallizations, metallic reflections, among others.

In 1990, she was in artistic residency in Italy where she learned the technique of black ceramic. Since 1991 shares a studio with the ceramist Carlos Lima in MOLELOS (Tondela/Portugal) a village that has a centuries-old tradition in this type of black pottery.

Together they have participated in exhibitions and biennials in Portugal, Spain, France, Germany, Ireland, Canada and Brazil. They are represented in private collections, in Museums and in books, where their work has been recognized in the preservation of this Cultural Heritage.

Since 2012, Xana has dedicated herself to designing installations with her own identity, where colorful textile threads are often present to highlight the black tone of the ceramics. His sculptural pieces have been an innovation in this type of black ceramics.
