### ARTISTIC STATEMENT:

Clay as a material has been my companion for years. I have been working with clay most of my life, and think of it as me working together with the clay, collaborating with it and challenging it to do its best, as the clay is challenging me. Porcelain gives the fine details and clear colors, but is also a material that will never let me take good results for granted. Porcelain has been teaching me the nature of clay, as it reveals any mistake I make during the process of making. This has also taught me to be observant to unexpected happenings during the whole process and never to work in an automatic manner.

The surface has always been of great interest. It may be seductive, treacherous, cold, warm, or have almost any character. Underneath it processes are going on that creates tensions on the surface. They are the only possibilities to understand what is happening behind the surface. Is it by studying a surface possible to have a glimpse of, or understand what is going on behind it? How do we project our own experiences to the interpretation of a surface?

I am especially interested in materials and techniques, and continuously experiment with new techniques and surface possibilities.

Whether I make abstract forms or figuratives, the hidden messages behind the surface are open to interpretations for the viewer.

My works are fragments of processes going on for a long time. The creation of a piece may have similarities to writing poems or short stories, as they often are carrying stories or are interpretations of impressions. An idea may come back in a new shape after some time of maturing.
