#### **Biography**

Nataša Sedej is a comparative literature graduate who fell in love with ceramics and sculpture. Her artistic journey began in 1990 when she first encountered clay. She immediately felt a special bond with the material, which is so alive and expressive. She bought her own pottery kiln and scholarshiped herself for the next four years to independently researched clay, glazes and ceramics technology in general. Since then, she has dedicated herself to ceramic, which she combines with wire, porcelain and tiny shards of glass.

She was the co-founder and president of the Association of Ceramists Gaia (1996-2008) which organized the 1st and 2nd Biennale of Slovenian Ceramics (2004, 2007), with renowned jury members (Hanibal Salvaro, Nicholas Lees; Franz Stahler, Torbjørn Kvasbø).

In 2008, she co-founded the Institute for Lifelong Learning and the Production of the Creative Events» Breakfast in the Clay Miner«, within which she coordinates the Creative School of Ceramics, mentors study circles and the Mini School of Ceramics, and organizes workshops with established teachers and artists.

2016 she started the project Forma viva Magic of Clay - a permanent international open-air exhibition of ceramic sculptures, located in the middle of the unspoilt nature of the Ad Pirum Archaeological Park in Hrušica. Forma viva Magic of Clay connects contemporary artworks with nature and develops an open-air gallery, on the edge of the forest, where artists, visitors and the local population meet each other more profoundly. It is also The Accompanying exhibition of the Unicum International Triennial of Ceramics. Since 2016 the exhibition Forma Viva take place every year with invited established Slovenian and foreign artists.

She is an active member of the Society of Ceramists and Potters of Slovenia and a member of the Association of Fine Artists of Slovenia.

She was exhibited at many juried international exhibitions and received numerous awards and recognitions. Her works are in public galleries and museum collections in Slovenia and abroad. She lives and creates in Postojna and Hrušica, where she has her studio.

With new approaches, she goes beyond the traditional conception of ceramics. In her works, she explores the idea of how to create a sculptural space with a three-dimensional drawing made of an infinite number of white clay particles that create their own spaces.

### **Artists Statement**

»My work looks ordered, but it is not. A geometrical principle mutates into an organic form, intuitively following the geometry of nature. It can reconstruct itself in every moment. It is constantly open to various possibilities, interactions and connections. This openness is fundamental and urgent to me. The balance I establish is always fragile and delicate – it is only a temporary state in a dynamic system. An optional play of elementary narticles

My forms are inspired by poetry and nature. I look for harmony between organic and inorganic, between fragility and strength, chaos and order. I create floating forms, poetic installations and three-dimensional drawings made of infinite white clay particles that create their own spaces. With my creations, I explore sculptural space and its connection with movement, gravity and light.«
