I have worked in the *International School Nido de Aguilas* since 2000, starting as a teacher assistant in Elementary School, with students from 1st to 5th grade. Starting from 2006, I work as a Pre-K, K1 and K2 Art teacher in the Early Years School Division (EYS). I have 17 classes with students between the ages of 4 to 6. My role as a teacher of younger children is to introduce them to different techniques and materials through art exercises that relate to their class curriculum, where the process of exploring and making art is valued more than the outcome.

Since 1998 I have been a member of the ceramics studio *Huara Huara* and starting 2005 I am a teacher assistant. My group is varied and composed mainly of college students, professionals of different areas, and seniors. My labor consists in guiding members in the studio throughout the creative process and managing the studio's formalities, procedures, rules, fees, and reports.

Throughout the years, I have met recognized ceramists like Warren Mackenzie, Magdalene Odundo, Gustavo Perez, Shozo Michikawa, and Rafa Perez. I was Rafa Perez's assistant during his first workshop at *Huara Huara* ceramic studio.

I've had individual art exhibitions, **Curado de Espanto** in *Corporación Cultural de Las Condes* and **Oblongo** in *Galería Animal*, as well as various collective ones. **The first international gallery in which I have participated as a consolidated artist was recently in February 2019 at Saint Mary Virgin Gallery in New York City.**
