#### BIOGRAPHICAL SUMMARY

In 1977, Daniela Schlagenhauf left Switzerland after High school diploma and went initially to France for a short time to take pottery-training courses. Yet, she stayed two years, working in the studios of Jean Linard, Claire Berger and Claude Champy. This led to two major decisions: to stay in France and to continue working with clay. So, in 1980, she built a two-chambered wood fire kiln sharing a collective studio with Mechthild Buschulte in the French Cantal. In 1982, she established her own studio in the Cantal Mountains, in a former isolated barn where she still lives and works today.

From 2009, a new body of work evolved focusing on inter-relationship of ceramics and signs. Since, her pieces are no longer the support of written signs but are signs/signifiers themselves. Huge abstract sculptures created in paper-porcelain arise. They defy the material, drawing in the emptiness.

It was a questioning time too: in 2010, she began a cycle of installations artworks under the theme "Resonances" which has led to 8 installations up to now. Each new installation is first inspired by a personal major life experience but is governed by a protocol of action similar to the constraints imposed on themselves by the OULIPO French writers.

These achievements enabled her, since 2012, to be selected for exhibitions, symposia and residencies around the world, employing the idea that ceramics is inseparable from poetry/writing; they are two methodologies involved in a search beyond meaning.
