Biographical Summary

Dr Cathy Franzi is a ceramic artist and educator based in Canberra, Australia. She holds a Bachelor of Science from the University of Sydney and a Master of Visual Arts from the Australian National University. In 2015 she was awarded a PhD from the ANU School of Art & Design, the culmination of four years of intense research into the intersection of ceramic studio practice, botanical science and printmaking.

Franzi has exhibited widely nationally and in the United States and in Germany as part of Berlin Design Week 2023 and is represented by Sabbia Gallery. She received a Highly Commended in the Waterhouse Natural Science Art Prize and most recently in the Siliceous Award for Ceramic Excellence. Franzi's work is held in public collections including Grassi Museum of Applied Arts in Leipzig, Germany, Shepparton Art Museum, Tasmanian Museum & Art Gallery and Canberra Museum & Art Gallery. She is the recipient of multiple grants including from Creative Australia, a former President of The Australian Ceramics Association and is a lecturer at the ANU.
