Having spent 25 years in the Nursing profession, in 2002 she commenced a degree course at NCAD (The National College of Art and Design, Dublin) and discovered clay. She graduated with 1st Class Honours in 2006 and was selected as a 'New Emerging Maker' by the Crafts Council of Ireland. In 2010 she completed a Masters in Design(Ceramics) at NCAD. Eleanor established her studio at Russborough House, County Wicklow, Ireland in 2011, a place which continues to provide endless inspiration for her work. Eleanor is passionate about clay and its endless possibilities. She is a handbuilder at heart and uses a variety of clays, from grogged architectural clay for her large sculptural pieces to a fine porcelain for her more delicate work. Always pushing boundries she enthusiastically embraces the art of the design process.

Eleanor has exhibited extensively both nationally, and internationally in Japan, Chicago, China, Latvia, San Francisco, Taiwan, Toronto, and won Bronze at the Taiwan Ceramics Biennale in 2016.
