Jane Annois prepares for the return of the French potters

Warrandyte is preparing for a French flurry in February 2015, continuing the French Australian ceramic exchange which has been underway since 2004. With each adventure the exchange has grown and developed to include new French and Australian artists. The inspirations stemming from these foreign encounters will become tangible in an exhibition at Manningham City Gallery MC2 in February 2015. These artists participated in the biannual potters market at Dieulefit back in May 2013, and now in 2015 it's our turn to host the French, repay their hospitality, share our workshops and homes and enjoy a reunion of ceramic artists. A soiree will be held at MC2 on Thursday 19 February where they will talk about their work and show images of their home studios and environment.

While in Australia, the French will also be running workshops for young ceramic artists at Art Play at Birrarung Marr, participating in Pottery Expo at Warrandyte and then heading north to Tanja on the south NSW coast for their exhibition at Narek Gallery.
