Gadiel Rivera Herrera

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Gadiel Rivera Herrera was born in 1963 at San Juan, Puerto Rico. Started his studies in Ceramics and Sculpture at the Universidad Interamericana Puerto Rico, San Germán Campus (1988). Obtained a B.A. in Sculpture from Escuela de Artes Plásticas in San Juan (1991). At this moment Rivera Herrera is in the final stages of an art residency at Museo de Arte de Puerto Rico (MAPR) with a grant from the Darryl Chappell Foundation (8/2022- 5/2023). His residency project *Mar adentro, historias profundas* (In Sea, Deep Histories), an individual exhibition, is currently on view at MAPR until 08/18/2023. At present Gadiel artwork is also exhibited as part of *El Arte como re-existencia: lo Afropuertorriqueño* curated by Dr. Maria Elba Torres at Museo de Historia Antropología y Arte, Universidad de Puerto Rico (4/2023); and at the juried exhibition *Small Favors* at The Clay Studio, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (4/2023). This year his work will be included at two upcoming exhibitions *Puerto Rico Negrx* currated by Marina Reyes at Museo de Arte Contemporáneo (MAC) in San Juan, PR (10/2023) and in *Alto, ancho, fondo*, a juried exhibition at Museo de Arte Francisco Oller in Bayamon, PR (8/2023). As a resident artist, Rivera Herrera has offered artistic experiences to students from elementary schools to undergraduate university level in a diverse academic institutions and settings, as well as to adults and elderly at community-based projects. From 2015 to 2022 he offered the courses "Introduction to Ceramics" and the "Ceramist Wheel" as part of the University of Puerto Rico, Rio Piedras Campus, Extended Education and Professional Studies Division. Keeps a studio practice in ceramics and other media and teaches ceramic on an ongoing basis.
