## BIOGRAPHY

**João Carqueijeiro** was born in 1954 and is based in Porto, Portugal. In 1982 he completed the degree in Drawing at Cooperativa Árvore (ESAD), under Sá Nogueira's mentorship. He pursued his studies in ceramics and specialized in Potter's Wheel, Stoneware Glazing and Raku at Escola de Ceràmica de la Bisbal, in Catalonia, Spain. Since 1985 he has been teaching ceramics, both Professional Training and in Specialization Courses, as well as Internship Orientation, Workshops and Course Programming. He is a Ceramics Trainer, accredited by the Scientific-Pedagogical Council for Continuing Education since 1995 and by the portuguese Institute for Employment and Vocational Training. Teaches Ceramic Courses at Cooperativa Árvore since 1986, of which he is also a partner. In 2005, was a founding member of the Ceramics Project "Oficina 2000 & 5". In 2007, he was a member of the Jury, at the 8th International Biennial of Artistic Ceramics in Aveiro.
