## **DARIA KROTOVA**

Daria Krotova was born in Moscow in 1971.

She holds university degrees from Russia (Moscow State University), the USA (UNCW) and France (University of Provence), in Neuropsychology and History of Art. Her research centered on the interaction between text and image in the Russian avant-garde.

Since 2007, she has been in over 60 solo and group exhibitions in Russia, Austria, Germany, France, UK, Switzerland, Belgium, Israel, Turkey, Georgia.

She works mainly in the fields of sculpture and installations, using media such as ceramics, paper, textiles.

Her works are in different galeries, museums and private collections in the USA (Kramlich family, New Art Trust), the UK (Charles Saatchi), France, Belgium, Austria, Israel, Switzerland, Russia. She is a regular participants at art fairs (Art Paris, Vienna Contemporary, Cosmoscow, Art Vilnius, Art Istanbul, Art Moscow...).

Alongside her career in contemporary art, she also teaches ceramics and sculpture. In 2018, the programme she initiated for children with learning disabilities at the renown Tretyakov Gallery in Moscow where she taught sculptures for 5 years and promoted an inclusive policy, was awarded the All Russia Intermuseum Prize (the highest award for Museums). She has also contributed in several projects for children hospitals. Daria is a member of The International Council of Museums (ICOM), and The International Association of Art Critics (AICA).

She has also translated major authors such as Maurice Blanchot, Gilles Deleuze, Francis Ponge, and William Butler Yeats.

She lives and works between south of France and Moscow.
