Artist's Statement

In Lee's signature work, he throws classic forms and uses surface textures to give energy and vitality resulting in art that is both pleasing and alive. "I seek to create patterns and textures that emphasize the organic interplay between order and randomness as found in Nature." Lee uses multiple glazes to intensify the dynamic tension in his surfaces. Although functional, his work is often prized as decorative.
