Merja Nieminen is a Finnish visual artist working primarily in ceramic sculpture. Her current practice investigates themes of architectural fragility, transformation, and collapse, often using porcelain and stoneware in combination with wood-firing processes. Nieminen holds academic backgrounds in architecture and media art, having studied at Aalto University and Edinburgh University. Her work evolved from abstract 3D animation installations (2009–2014) to ceramic-based sculpture since 2017. In 2024, she completed a 3.5-month residency at the Shigaraki Ceramic Cultural Park in Japan. Nieminen is a member of the Association of Finnish Sculptors (since 2022) and the Finnish Artists' Association (since 2004).
