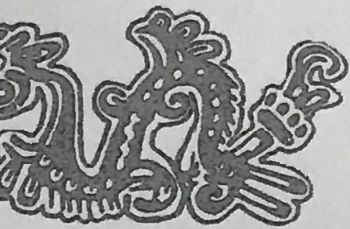

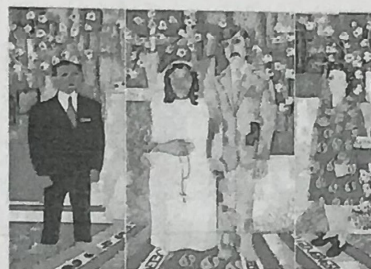

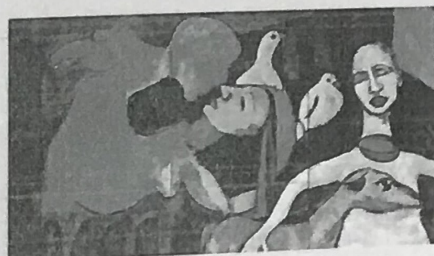

## Message from the General Consul of Spain
