## Biography

Rashi Jain has trained in ceramics and visual art at The Valley School, Bangalore, The Golden Bridge Pottery, Pondicherry and in anatomy studies at The Ruskin School of Fine Art, University of Oxford.

She has been exhibiting her work across India; shows such as Porcelain India (India Habitat Center, Delhi), Bridges: Indian Contemporary Ceramics (The Stainless, Delhi), Earth Matters (Indo Korean Center & Lalit Kala Akademi, Chennai), Jeff Shapiro and Friends (Bharat Niwas, Auroville) and Jar of Secrets (The Jehangir Art Gallery, Mumbai, solo show). Rashi has recently been invited to The Paperclay Illuminated, touring across USA until 2021.

Rashi has been invited to residencies, such as Inko-Lalit Kala Akademi and KYTA. She has been awarded the NCECA Multi-cultural fellowship and a scholarship to attend the Alps Art Academy/Land Art symposium, Switzerland.

She works with traditional potter communities across India and has conducted vocational training programmes in Mumbai and the north-east of India. Rashi has co-founded the Studio Potters' Market movement in India, and curates markets annually, at the Kalaghoda Arts Festival, Mumbai.
