Artist Statement

Juan Villavicencio (b. 1986) is an Ensenada native, currently living and working in Tijuana, Baja California, México. He is a ceramic artist that investigates the boundaries between art, craft and design; simultaneously questioning Mexican identity. He creates one-of-a-kind objects that reference Mexican curios or kitsch crafts found in souvenir shops around Tijuana such as Talavera and velvet sculptures. Villavicencio considers the role these crafts have in the construction, representation, and commodification of US/Mx identities. His work playfully deploys visual elements sampled from prehispanic heritage, pop culture, traditional ceramic patterns, the natural world, and even graffiti: creating disjunctive and humorous juxtapositions. The artist often contrasts ideas of "authenticity" associated with handmade ceramics against the reality that many so-called "crafts" are mass-produced and bear little relationship to the region. His recent body of works, Oscuranas, reference velvet sculptures that could be found at shops near the US/Mx border. The Oscuranas are abstracted, high-fired, liquid-like ceramic forms covered in black velvet that seek to question volume, space and gravity.
