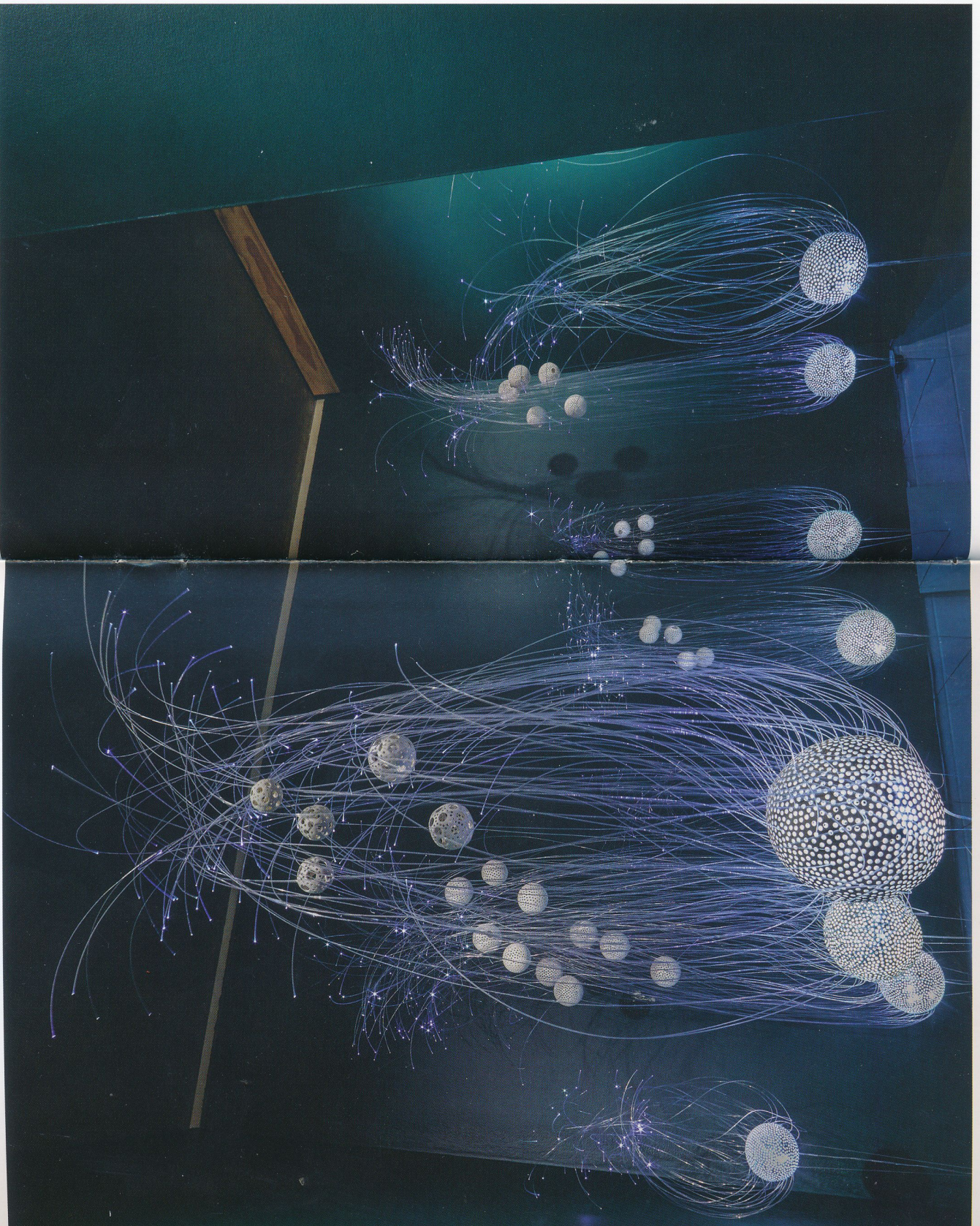


With an impressive exhibition roster that includes international solo and group shows in such countries as France, Germany, Korea, China, and Lithuania, Anne Türm is an Estonian-based artist. From 1984 to 1994, Türm pursued studies at the Tallinn Art University in Estonia and Kassel University in Germany. She was awarded "Ceramist of the Year" in 2011 in Estonia. Her body of ceramic work is vast and seductive in surface, with sculptures that take on an animal-like feel and are often placed outside and photographed in situ, akin to a landscape photographer's capture of an animal in its natural environment. Her "indoor" work can include multi-media "Valgusobjektid," or light sculptures, that marry porcelain, glass, and hundreds of fiber-optic light strands.
