What you have in hand is a classical path for somebody with an academical career. Once I graduated in History of Art and wanting to specialize in Theory of Arts, I studied a degree in Philosophy. Immediately I was awarded with a Research Fellowship to do my PhD Thesis and, four years later, I read it obtaining the maximum grade. The following year I had an associate professor contract at the Autonomous University of Barcelona (UAB) and the following one I became associate professor at the Faculty of Humanities of the Pompeu Fabra University of Barcelona (UPF) where I grew professionally obtaining the Lecturer accreditation.

When the design studies became a university degree in Spain and the Bachelors's Degrees of Design Studies were founded, I received a proposal to occupy an ownership on History and Theory of Design at the EINA University Center for Design and Art of Barcelona, which is attached to the Autonomous University of Barcelona (EINA / UAB). This proposal is what has finally guided my professional path as an academic.

It is difficult to define the scientific milestones that accompany this 30-year academic career.
