From December 13 to 15, Manises, a UNESCO Creative City internationally recognized as the cradle of ceramics, will host the fourth edition of The Turn of the Wheel.

This event has established itself as one of the most prominent gatherings in the national ceramics scene. This year, the AVEC-Gremio facilities will be the venue where over 70 ceramic artists will come together to share, explore, and celebrate the art of the potter's wheel.

FEATURED SPEAKERS

The event will feature three renowned figures from the ceramics world, whose work exemplifies the richness and diversity of the craft:

•Rogelio Enríquez, a ceramist and sculptor celebrated for his ability to merge functionality and aesthetics, creating works that blur the lines between traditional pottery and conceptual sculpture.

•Eugenia Boscá, whose sensitivity and technical mastery have made her a reference in the reinterpretation of classical ceramic techniques with a contemporary and exclusive design approach.

•Aniana Heras, an artist who delves into the poetics of material and processes, offering a unique perspective on the relationship between ceramics and personal narrative.

A UNIQUE PERFORMANCE

One of the most anticipated moments of this edition will be the firing performance of a large-format stoneware tree, directed by master ceramist Antonio Pérez Reguena.

On Saturday, a 3-meter-tall kiln will be opened at 1,000°C, offering a spectacular display of technique, emotion, and creativity.

This performance will pay homage to the connection between clay and fire, the essential elements of ceramics, brought to life in a unique event that promises to captivate the audience.

In addition to lectures and demonstrations, this edition will emphasize the duality between functionality and sculpture, showcasing how the potter's wheel becomes a versatile tool for both artistic expression and utilitarian creation.
